SHERIFF'S REPORT:

 Deputy Humm reported that August had the lowest calls for service since January 2018 for the Village Township. Technically you must have driver's license in order to ride one, but seeing they don't ride on Route 64, just in the subdivision, Deputy Humm did not see any harm in it.

RESOLUTIONS AND ORDINANCES: none

PRESIDENT'S REPORT:

- President LeBlanc reported about the IC Trail Bridge (built in 1974), that Baxter & Woodman has
 determined that the condition of the beams on the bridge has been worsening and they are suggesting
 we do some rehab work.
 - They have also suggested that we make the needed upgrades to the guard rails so that they meet current code regulations.
 - o The bridge has become eligible for a Federal Bridge Funding Program because of its age.
 - The engineer will be sending over a repair proposal, suggested timeline and information on how
 we submit for the Federal Bridge Funding Program, and possible how much we could possibly
 receive from the program.
- · President LeBlanc reported on Meredith Road Drainage Scope and Fees. See attached.
 - Options 1 and 2 consisted of topographic survey (1 day) of the potential storage basin area and ground surface profile of the sewer alignment, this includes time to discuss further storm sewer connections with permitting agencies but does not include an alternatives evaluation or summary memo.
 - Evaluation of future storm sewer connections is included as an option, which we can move forward with if we determine they can be permitted.
 - We will model the additional tributary drainage areas and size of the proposed storm sewer to accommodate this additional flow.
 - o We will also confirm that it will not exacerbate flooding at the known problem area.
 - o Including a storage basin (west of Meredith Road) in the XP-SWMM model is an option.
 - Doing so could potentially reduce the size and cost of the storm sewer or increase its
 effectiveness.
 - o Design of the storage basin is included as an option, which will include preparing a grading plan, planting plan, and cost estimate
