- I communicated with Baxter & Woodman regarding the property at 7N088 Sauber Rd regarding compliance with Floodplain guidelines per the IL EPA and Army Corps of Engineer. Kane Count provided clarification on the vehicles allegedly stored on the property and B&W will inspect for compliance.
- We received two FOIA requests from the Painters District 30 regarding water towers, water storage tanks, water storage facilities, any contracts and/or employee info regarding them. I sent a response and followed up via phone call and email since the first responses were returned as undeliverable.
- We received a FOIA request from NBC5 regarding unclaimed property and our treasurer sent our response.
- We received our insurance renewal and I recommend we pay early and in full to receive a sligh discount. As mentioned last month, the rates stayed the same as last year.
- Our response to the American Rescue Plan Act was submitted by our treasurer and we successfully qualified for \$44,453.76. I also spoke with the Kane County Board Chairwoman and Kane County will engage an accounting firm to advise on eligibility in the fund usage. She offered this firm's services to validate any potential projects we would consider using the funds on. The funds must be used within five years.
- Our copier lease is up for renewal, the invoice is included in this month's bills to be voted on.
