PUBLIC COMMENT:

- The Millers (living across Frank Hartman's property on IC Trail) discussed the development of a solar field by a Chicago based developer and their concerns about the speed and lack of consideration of resident's feedback
- President LeBlanc advised that we unfortunately have planning jurisdiction but Kane County may take our feedback about certain projects into consideration
- The Miller's advised they also spoke with Lily Lake and that Kane County Zoning Meeting passed the proposal even though there was a lot of opposition
- Their main concern was maintenance of the solar field after construction and what vegetation was being planted to obscure it from view (effect on other properties)
- They also advised that the developer previously communicated but ceased all efforts after their proposal passed
- Their main concern is that nobody seemed to listen
- The property is located between Lily Lake and Virgil (about 50 acres and the proposed solar field would occupy about 40 acres)
- There is increased development of solar fields in the area since the state has incentivized solar farms
- Their main concern was the speed of the approval

Board Meeting – Clerk Report October 12, 2023 7:00 p.m.

- We received a phone call from a WI firm wanting to install a solar field on a property on the south side of IC Trail. I asked them to email the details but have not received any info. Per an email from Lily Lake, this is their planning area but it's close to our boundary.
- We received the insurance renewal invoice and I will review and advise once we receive the renewal.
- We received a phone call from the owner/resident at 7N088 Sauber Rd regarding the condition of his property and President LeBlanc will discuss the details with him. The resident is very willing to do what is necessary to comply.
- We received our notice to renew our Federal SAM registration (System of Award Management) for being eligible for government funding. We will work on getting this done.
- The Outbound Geneva Metra Platform is being closed starting 10/9/2023 through the end of 2024 for rehabilitation.
- I have sent out the Sexual Harassment training we are required to have.
 Please read the material and sign/date the last page and return it to me by the next board meeting. All elected officials and employees must comply. This is per the State of IL.
- Dave Kosarek was our GIS contact for Kane County. I need another trustee to take his place. Please let me know who wants to take on this responsibility.
- I submitted a special use permit to Trustee Roger and Attorney McTavish.
- I updated our Hazard Mitigation Plan with Kane County by advising them we are looking at tornado sirens.
- There is a possible new buyer for Chuck's and they inquired about the liquor license. I advised that a new one had to be completed and paid for since the name of the business is changing. I have sent out the application and they will return it to me.

• We received the proposal from Schenk Builders for Snow Removal. I asked if they would give us another 3 year proposal and have not heard back.

Presidents Report - October 12, 2023

Kane County Hazard Mitigation

- Virgil has completed the needed requirements and is now included in Kane County Hazard Mitigation Plan.
- This opens up certain funding avenues for the Village and residents in case a Presidential disaster is declared
- I proposed two different ideas as we needed to provide hazard projects. The two were:
 - Tornado sirens
 - o Grant to offset cost of back-up generator for all residents
- Kane County went with the tornado siren as our project.

Church Property Drainage

- Baxter & Woodman is advocating a 24" drainage pipe with an additional manhole away from the trees on Meredith using a natural catch basin to take in the surface water. Estimated cost: \$98,000
- Going to a 12" drain tile reduces the estimated cost down to \$81,000
- They also have two other estimates for both 24" & 12" drainage tile that include multiple manholes for \$312,000 & \$287,000 respectively.

SafeBuilt

- My contact has sent over a revised contract with Alex's updates.
- I sent it over for Alex to review. Once good, I will sign and I can start working with their team to set up a portal.
