- o **47W504 IC Trail** Mr. Brummel was a no-show at the hearing. Fines are now \$100 a day.
- 6N221 Meredith Road contractor completed work and Baxter & Woodman came out to inspect this past Tuesday. I have not heard if everything is completed per code from Baxter & Woodman.
- Kane County Forest Preserve Forest Preserve Board approved the intergovernmental agreement Tue 8/13. We will approve it tonight and then I can sign it and send it back. The agreement had a clause (I called the Forest Preserve about) that they wanted to see an updated plat showing placement of all infrastructure.
