#### **PUBLIC COMMENT:**

Nick Petit spoke regarding the flood plain in Virgil. It was a swamp before the bridge came in and the flood plain does not show up on the Flood Plain map. The last great flood was in 2019. He was concerned as on the drawings he saw for the 64 Corral the flood plain did not appear. He has known the area in which 64 Correl, known in the past as "Chucks" has flooded from front to back. President LeBlanc stated he has provided Dan White the owner of 64 Corral the 8 page form that needed to be completed and returned to the Engineers. Until the completed form is received everything is a full stop. Mr. Petit just wanted to be sure the Engineer was aware of the flooding. Mr. Petit also mentioned there is a history of flooding and that the wet hole does not show up on FEMA or the County map. It is known that Virgil floods and water can sit on people's property for 2 to 3 days at a time.

# Presidents Report – April 10<sup>th</sup>, 2024

• ComEd & Tornado Siren – ComEd refused our Commercial & Industrial Load Application because the site does not have a street address. In working with Kane County, I submitted a permit for new electrical service this past Sunday (4/6). As part of that review, Kane County will assign a street address to the parcel. Once I have that I can resubmit the Commercial & Industrial Load Application to ComEd, they will assign a Project Engineer to the application. Once I have that, I can arrange an on-site meeting with ComEd, our electrical contractor, and myself to discuss options, make a game plan, and set up a timeline to get our siren installed and operational.

#### Citations

- 07N088 Sauber Rd the owner has not meet certain the timeline I forwarded to him back in December. There is a hearing scheduled for April 16<sup>th</sup> to further discuss with the hearing judge and set fines in motion.
- 64 Corral (Chuck's) Dan White has submitted his fee for the Storm Water Permit process with Baxter & Woodman. I sent Dan the eight-page application and suggested he have his engineers fill it out as it is very detailed in what it wants. Doing so will minimize the overall cost to the applicant as all the needed information for the review by Baxter & Woodman is contained in that application. The Village is still waiting to have the application filled out and submitted for review.
- Maple Park & Elburn Boundary Agreements I have not received any feedback from Maple Park and followed up with them accordingly. I did receive a modified request from Elburn. The original request was Rt. 47 west on Beith to Francis Rd, then south on Francis Rd. to Rt. 38. They want to further extended it west on Rt. 38 to the Union Pacific tracks, west on the tracks to the western border of the Aquviva Winery property, south along their property line to Rt. 38, Rt. 38 east to Meredith Rd, then south on Meredith Rd. until Meredith ends at Kessinger Rd. Basically they want to include Aquaviva Winery in their agreement as well as the school campus as it is served by their sewer & water.
- Compass Equestrian I received a request from Steve to approve plans for a new hay barn on the property. I approved and sent them to Kane County Planning & Development to submit their plans to receive a building permit.


